SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES:

The First Presbyterian Church has been generously endowed by church members who have, through gifts and memorials, established a scholarship fund that provides financial resources to be awarded to full-time undergraduate students each year. The value of each scholarship will vary according to the returns on the invested funds and the number of qualified applicants.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must be active members of Bucyrus First Presbyterian Church during their sophomore, junior and senior years of high school. An active member attends worship services regularly and is involved in church activities.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Applications will become available in January during the year of application. Applications may be picked up at the church office or may be acquired from the church website.
2. Completed applications, current school transcript (s), a letter of recommendation and a photo must be returned to the Finance Team at the Bucyrus First Presbyterian Church office by April 15th. Please check with the church office to verify that your application has been received by the church administrative assistant. Please neatly print your information. Additional paper may be used if more room is needed for any responses. It is most important that your responses are detailed and complete to help the Finance Team better know you. Any questions should be directed to the Treasurer, Jan Fulton (419/561-0263).
3. After reviewing all applications, the Finance Team will contact all applicants by mail. The scholarship recipients will be invited to the presentation of awards during a worship service in May. Recipients are expected to attend this presentation. If unable to attend, the student must contact the chairperson of the Finance Team prior to the awards service.
4. This application is for one academic school year; however, a student may reapply in following years if qualifications are met. Students may only receive a total of four scholarships.
