You Have Not, Because You Ask Not

Recently I was meeting with a group of fellow EPC pastors from our Presbytery, and we were talking about developing a greater vision for seeing people come to faith through the ministry of our church and its members. There is truly something beautiful and soul stirring to see God work faith into someone's heart, and for that person to come before your church, professing their faith, and being baptized into the covenant family. But the question was, "why are we not seeing this more often in our churches?"

And, I think, it's because we have lost sight of what God has called us to do as a church. We are to be a people of Good News—and not just on Sunday morning! God has called us to go to the lost and dying with the word of truth, the message of the gospel. And, I know many of you feel insecure about sharing the Gospel. But, before we talk about sharing the Gospel, I want to spend the rest of this letter taking a step back with the first thing we should do: Pray.

In this meeting I was at with my fellow pastors, one of them told this story. At their church, they had gone a very, very long time without seeing a believer's baptism—that is, an adult who professed faith in Christ for the first time and was baptized into church membership. So, this pastor put forth a challenge to his church. He said, "Let's pray, and let's ask God to use our church to bring 15 people to faith in the next year." He put it before the elders and the members of the church. They prayed for it every time they were together. They took pictures of the person each time someone professed faith and was baptized so that everyone could see what God was doing.

After he told us this story, he said, "I realized we had not, because we asked not." Yes, they had asked God to use them, and I'm sure God had used them. But now, they were asking specifically to see people in their community come to faith in Jesus. And that year, they had *more* than 15 people come to faith.

So, this is our challenge. Let's pray specifically that God would use our church, and would use us individually, to bring people to faith. Let's keep the work God has already done before our eyes (people like Levi who was recently baptized), and let's keeping going forward to share the love and good news of Jesus to our neighbors!


